LANGUAGE ARTS

- Practice spelling words, vocabulary, and sight words
- Continue to develop writing concepts, sentence structure, and grammar usage
- Use a variety of writing styles to develop and refine the writing process
- Practice cursive writing
- Classify sentences and identify parts of speech
- Read a variety of genres and continue to develop comprehension strategies using novels and reading anthologies

MATHEMATICS

- Mastery and quick recall of basic addition and subtraction facts
- Use addition and subtraction facts for multi-digit problems with regrouping
- Quick recall of multiplication facts 0-12
- Develop knowledge of basic division with whole numbers
- Solve problems using basic fractions, units of measurement, patterns, graphs, and number lines
- Continue to develop knowledge of calendars, estimation, time and temperature
- Use multiple strategies to effectively solve multi-step word problems

VISUAL & PERFORMING ARTS

- Introduce the difference between realistic and abstract art
- Recognize and create texture and value in a piece of art
- Begin to recognize major and minor intervals
- Introduction to ukulele including strumming and one-string melody playing

TECHNOLOGY & STEM

- Use computer as a learning tool through internet research, digital painting and drawing, reading software, word processing, touch typing practice and slideshow presentations
- Continue to learn to code while developing patience, persistence, and problem solving abilities
- Learn the basics of circuitry using electronic building blocks

SCIENCE

- Plan and carry out investigations using the scientific method
- Explore Life Science including animal behaviors, adaptations, and their roles in the ecosystem
- Explore Earth Science including factors that can change an environment and weather
- Explore Physical Science including forms of energy and states of matter
- Explore the study of space and technology

SOCIAL STUDIES

- Explore geography and map skills
- Investigate how people from around the world become part of our country
- Discover what makes a community diverse and how people are alike and different
- Analyze how a community works on a local and global scale

SPANISH

- Understand that knowing more than one language connects people and makes it possible to discover similarities and differences
- Practice numbers 1-31, months of the year, the date, the rooms in house/furnishings, descriptive adjectives, prepositions, clothing, alphabet letter names, school classes, and how to (politely) express our wants and needs

- Explore stories of the Old Testament focusing on specific people and their actions
- Look more broadly at Jesus' life among us, and the people he taught, preached to, and healed
