READING / LANGUAGE

- Develop print awareness, phonemic awareness, and alphabet knowledge.
- Practice sustained attention and engagement by listening to a story and participating in circle time.
- Utilize listening skills and practice following oral directions.
- · Recognize and learn to write first name.

MATH

- Develop number awareness and proper formation of numbers 0-10.
- Recite numbers in order (0-20).
- Identify patterns, shapes, and colors.
- Practice the days of the week and months of the year.

SCIENCE

- · Investigate the four seasons and weather.
- Discover that nature is all around us, including plants and animals.

SOCIAL STUDIES

- Introduce and begin to develop the concept of self, family, community helpers, and holidays.
- Practice communication skills, sharing and taking turns, kindness, good manners, and identifying feelings.

FINE AND GROSS MOTOR DEVELOPMENT

- Demonstrate body and spatial awareness.
- Develop fine motor skills by manipulating objects with increasing control, making basic marker strokes, and attempting to use scissors.
- Demonstrate basic large motor skills (running, jumping, hopping).

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

- Introduce the concept of God's love for all people and creatures.
- Introduce and practice The Lord's Prayer.

ART

- · Explore a variety of art mediums.
- Create artwork using different tools and textures.

MUSIC

- Explore sounds, melodies, and rhythms.
- Use our voice to speak, chant, and sing.

LIBRARY

- · Learn the proper care of library books and begin to understand expected library manners.
- Explore developmentally appropriate children's literature through interactive storytime sessions that include music, movement, and crafts.

SPANISH

- Understand that our world is made up of many places where people speak different languages.
- Implement a routine for attendance, prayer, greetings, weather and feelings.
- Learn basic manners and understand basic classroom instructions.
- · Practice counting up to 20.
- Express simple likes and dislikes.
- Introduce the concept of grammatical gender.
- · Focus on vocabulary units such as animals, body parts, family, clothing, colors, and food.
- Complete a cultural mini-unit on one specific Spanish-speaking country each quarter.

WELLNESS

- Practice calming breaths.
- Learn appropriate personal space.
- Practice age appropriate social skills such as sharing and taking turns.
