LANGUAGE ARTS

- Develop print awareness, phonemic awareness, and alphabet knowledge.
- Introduce basic oral comprehension strategies such as predicting, sequencing, retelling, illustrating, visualizing, and rhyming.
- · Recognize first and last name.
- · Introduce basic sight words and decoding skills.

MATH

- Develop number awareness and formation of numbers 0-20.
- Develop number patterns and relationships.
- Introduce measurement, graphing, money, time, and 3D shapes.
- Introduce basic addition and subtraction through use of manipulatives.

SCIENCE

- Observe and investigate plants, animals, and weather.
- · Describe what living things need to grow.
- · Learn about the cycles of life and life changes.

SOCIAL STUDIES

- Develop social skills and responsibility.
- Develop concepts about the self, family, community, community helpers, holidays, and people and places around the world.

FINE AND GROSS MOTOR DEVELOPMENT

- Demonstrate body and self-awareness.
- Use appropriate gross motor skills when running, jumping, throwing, and catching.
- Develop fine motor skills through replicating shapes, drawing people, printing short words and name.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

- · Practice talking to God through prayer.
- Learn about celebrations in the church calendar (Advent, Christmas, Lent, Easter).

ART

- Practice using scissors.
- Use a variety of art mediums to create works of art.

MUSIC

- Experiment with a variety of instruments and sources of sound.
- · Respond to music through movement.

LIBRARY

- · Learn the proper care of library books and begin to understand expected library manners.
- Explore developmentally appropriate children's literature through interactive storytime sessions that include music, movement, and crafts.

SPANISH

- Understand that our world is made up of many places where people speak different languages.
- Implement a routine for attendance, prayer, greetings, weather and feelings.
- Learn basic manners and understand basic classroom instructions.
- Practice counting up to 20.
- · Express simple likes and dislikes.
- Introduce the concept of grammatical gender.
- · Focus on vocabulary units such as animals, body parts, family, clothing, colors, and food.
- Complete a cultural mini-unit on one specific Spanish-speaking country each quarter.

WELLNESS

- Practice calming breaths.
- Learn appropriate personal space.
- · Practice age appropriate social skills such as sharing and taking turns.
