For several years in a row recently, Grace was voted "Best Private School in Clay County."



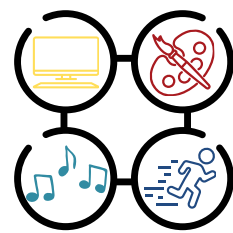
Grace students are able to participate in 6 after school sports throughout the school year.

Grace students are able to participate in over 15 different afterschool activities throughout the school year, in addition to sports.



For the 36th consecutive year, Grace families have partnered with the Green Cove Springs Food Pantry to donate almost 2,000 pounds of food annually.



Grace successfully partners with over 23 community businesses to benefit Grace's financial aid program. This year, these partners have contributed to over \$30,00 in funding.
